### Camp Summit

Please allow Kerry and me to reflect on the advancements that took place at Camp Summit during our second term of service in Costa Rica:

**Praise report:** During this term, Kerry and I hosted 12 construction teams in Costa Rica to build the facilities at Camp Summit. Camp Summit is the 80-acre training and discipleship center you helped us purchase in 1997. As the buildings have gone up, so have the ministries. The lives of thousands of men and boys have been impacted in the 34 training events we have held at the camp. One such activity is the "Campamento de Barras Doradas" (Gold Bar Training), which is designed to shape young men into outstanding leaders. It is a camp we launched from Camp Summit, and it is now being replicated in 19 Latin American countries.

**B**uilding opportunity: More than 15 building projects remain "unadopted." Construction teams are needed to provide funds and manpower. God has led missionaries John and Mary Anthony to serve as the construction supervisors at Camp Summit. We only have a two-year window to complete construction under their capable leadership. As long as the Lord tarries his return, there will be infinite opportunities for you to participate in worthy building projects like churches and schools. But when Camp Summit is built, the opportunity to invest in the first training and discipleship center for men and boys outside of the United States will have passed you by. This training center is a prototype of what will be done around the world. Therefore, the effects of your ministry at Camp Summit will be far-reaching.
